## SPRING 2018 Junior Soccer Program for Girls and Boys ~ 5, 6, and 7 Years Old



The Tumwater Soccer Club Junior Soccer Program is designed for 5, 6, and 7 year old's (see the age chart on the next page). The program introduces players to the game of soccer, while concentrating on developing skills and having fun. The Junior Soccer program provides one coach for every 5 to 8 players. *The emphasis is on fun and enjoyment, not competition.*

**WHEN:** Tuesday & Friday evenings (6:00 pm to 7:00 pm) starting on Tuesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> and ending on Friday, May 18<sup>th</sup>.

**WHERE:** Pioneer Park – 5801 Henderson Blvd., Tumwater, WA.

**COST:** \$45 per player (online registration) \$50 per player (mail-in)

**Family Discount:** Multiple player discount is available for families registering more than one child. Online: \$45 for 1<sup>st</sup> child, \$35 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and each additional child. By Mail: \$50 for 1<sup>st</sup> child, \$40 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and each additional child.

## JUNIOR SOCCER PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This program has two goals: (1) to provide a fun soccer-learning experience to youth players by having them work with experienced coaches and (2) to develop parent coaches for future years when the program for older children relies on parent coaches for teams that participate in league play during the spring, summer and fall.

On Tuesday evenings, experienced soccer coaches will lead older youth soccer players and parent coach volunteers in implementing age appropriate developmental games in an academy style program. Players will work on improving dribbling, passing, and other basic soccer skills through the use of drills and age-appropriate games. The emphasis is on fun and constant player activity. Parent coach volunteers will learn the basic structure of a soccer practice and be exposed to the skill development drills and games that will help prepare them to be confident successful coaches in the future.

On Friday evenings, the parent coaches with the assistance of the master coach will assist the players in forming teams and playing small sided games implementing the skills they have learned. The emphasis is on playing for fun; there is no score keeping as the primary focus of this super mod program is to provide the young players the basic skills to be successful confident players in the future.

**Coaches Needed! Volunteer parent coaches are reimbursed their child's registration fee at the conclusion of the fall program provided they participate in the entire program. No previous soccer or coaching experience is required! Guidance and mentoring during the sessions by an experienced coach will provide the volunteer coaches with a unique learning opportunity.**
