



Summer 2018 Recreational Soccer for Girls and Boys ~ 8 to 19

REGISTRATION Opens April 1st, 2018

Player Ages: The Summer recreational league is for players in the 8 through 19 age groups (see information on page 2 for age group definitions and program description).

Practices: Practices will begin the first week in June. Each team's coach determines the practice schedule. Practices are usually held on school fields in the Tumwater School District.

Games: Games begin mid-June and continue until the end of July. Girl teams typically play on Monday and Wednesday and Boy teams on Tuesday and Thursday. Teams may play two games per week; depends on final schedule. Games start at either 6:00 pm or 7:30 pm. Games are played against other recreational teams from Olympia, Shelton, Tenino, Tumwater, and Yelm areas.

Registration Notes: Players are not considered registered until their registration fee is received. Previous season players will be given one-week priority to register for a specific team. **Registration does not guarantee placement on a team.** Make-up of teams is dependent on number of children who register; factored for age and gender. **Please register early to guarantee placement with a specific team.** Financial assistance is available; requests should be mailed to: Tumwater Soccer Club, PO Box 14304, Tumwater, WA 98511.

**Registration is not accepted without age verification and full registration fee.
Players not previously registered with the Tumwater Soccer Club must provide
a copy of their birth certificate; mail to the address above.
(We will destroy the documentation copy after age is confirmed.)**

REGISTRATION FEES & PROCESS

\$65 (Online payment by credit card) Visit our website at www.tumwatersoccerclub.org and follow the directions to register. **Online registration closes Sunday, May 27th, 2018** (\$10 late fee after deadline).

\$75 (Mail-in and payment by check) Download the **registration form, concussion compliance form and the sudden cardiac arrest form** from our website. Completed forms and the player registration fee should be mailed to:

Mailed in registration forms must be postmarked no later than May 27th, 2018. (\$10 late fee after the deadline.)

Family Discount: Multiple player discount is available for families registering more than one child. Online: \$65 for 1st child, \$55 for 2nd and each additional child. By Mail: \$75 for 1st child, \$65 for 2nd and each additional child. (As noted above; late fees are incurred if registration(s) comes in after May 27th, 2018)

Ancillary Costs: There is typically an additional cost for a uniform for each player. The uniform cost is determined by the team. *For teams that provide volunteers to help in the annual Kick in the Grass Soccer Tournament sponsored by the Tumwater Soccer Club, the club provides a stipend to the team to help offset the cost of their uniforms, etc...* Parents should discuss this with the coach prior to the start of games as parent involvement is crucial for meeting the team's obligation for the KITG Tournament (July 13, 14, and 15).

SUMMER PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Modified Soccer (U8 – U12)

The “Modified” program is for 8-12 years old and provides a progressive development path leading up to full field 11-a-side play. Using smaller fields, smaller team sizes, and modified rules, the “Mod” program gives players more opportunities with the ball and involvement in the game, which enhances their skill development. Games are played once or twice during the week. The volunteer parent coaches will determine practice schedules.

11-a-side (Full-field) Soccer (U13 – U19)

11-a-side is played on a full-sized field. Games are played once or twice during the week. The volunteer parent coaches will determine practice schedules.

Volunteer Coaches Needed

A lack of coaches sometimes causes us not to be able to provide a team for registered players. To ensure that everyone has a team to play on we rely on volunteer coaches. ***Please consider guaranteeing your child a team to play on and volunteer to coach.*** If you would like to help coach your child’s team, please indicate this on the registration form or email Kurt Gress at kurt@wembleysoccer.com if you have questions. You do not need to be a skilled soccer player or have intimate knowledge of the game to get started. Enthusiasm and the desire to provide guidance to our youth and future leaders is all that is necessary. TSC and affiliated clubs provide training programs and services for our volunteer coaches.
