Spring 2019 Recreational Soccer Program for Girls ~ 13 to 18 and Boys ~ 13 to 16

REGISTRATION Opens January 1st, 2019

Player Ages: The Spring Recreational League is for players ages 13 through 18 (see information on page 2 for age group definitions and program description).

Practices: Practices will begin on March 4th. Each team's coach determines a team's practice schedule. Practices are usually held on school fields in the Tumwater School District, Capital Soccer Fields and Pioneer Park.

Games: Games will begin March 16th and continue until May 18th. Games will be played on Saturdays (there may be an occasional Friday or Sunday game). Games may be played in Thurston, Lewis, Grays Harbor, and Mason Counties. No Games will be scheduled on April 6th or April 7th due to Spring Break.

Registration Notes: Players are not considered registered until their registration fee is received. Registration does not guarantee placement on a team. ***Previous season players will be given one-week priority for placement on their team. After that week, placement is on a first come; first serve basis. Once a team is full you will be added to another team in that age bracket if it allows.*** Make-up of teams is dependent on number of children who register; factored for age and gender. Financial assistance is available; requests should be mailed to: Tumwater Soccer Club, PO Box 14304, Tumwater, WA 98511.

**Registration is not accepted without age verification and full registration fee.
Players not previously registered with the Tumwater Soccer Club must provide
a copy of their birth certificate; mail to the address above.

\$75 with Online payment by credit card (recommended): Visit our website at www.tumwatersoccerclub.org and follow the directions to register for the Spring League. On-line registration closes Sunday, February 10th, 2019 (After February 10th, there is an additional \$10 late fee added to registration).

FALL MOD PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

13 – 18 Recreational Soccer

Ages 13 to 18 recreational soccer is played 11-a-side on a full-sized field. Games are played on Saturdays with an occasional Friday or Sunday game. The volunteer parent coaches determine practice schedules.

Volunteer Coaches Needed

A lack of coaches sometimes causes us not to be able to provide a team for registered players. To ensure that everyone has a team to play on we rely on volunteer coaches. ***Please consider guaranteeing your child a team to play on and volunteer to coach.***
