

TCYSA Fall Season Field Marshal Guidance

Field Marshalls are an important part of any season and for Fall they will be critical to insuring a safe playing environment and compliance with TCYSA's COVID-19 policies.

TCYSA member Clubs are expected to secure Field Marshalls from among their volunteers (Board members, coaches, parents, ect.) with the intent to have one Field Marshall at each location where games are being played. TCYSA must have a minimum of 75% coverage during the season.

What is the role of Field Marshalls?

Field Marshalls are typically looking for compliance with all TCYSA rules including those around sideline and sportsmanship behavior. For Fall season they are also looking for compliance with TCYSA's COVID-19 policies.

Field Marshalls are encouraged to provide friendly reminders to those not complying. Field Marshall should take note of those who are not complying to report that information back to the member Clubs and TCYSA.

Field Marshalls should pay particular attention to compliance by coaches and players recognizing that it can be difficult to determine compliance among spectators.

Field Marshalls should not engage in any confrontations or escalate a confrontation but should focus on recording behavior and reporting it to the Clubs and TCYSA for follow up.
